Fourth Sunday of Lent Fr Tony writes: Rejoice!

That is the first word of the entrance antiphon today: in Latin Laetare, which gives this Sunday its name. It is also Mothering Sunday (or Mother's Day). There are a number of reasons for this link. The Entrance antiphon goes on to portray Jerusalem as a mother, and, perhaps linked to this, it was a day when people, especially those in 'service', returned to their 'mother church', the place of their baptism, and in doing so would also visit their own mothers, who likely still lived in the same parish.

This theme of return is found in our readings today. The people of Israel were exiled from their homeland under the Babylonians, but got to return to their own land after the Persians conquered the Babylonians.

Sometimes people wonder where all the young people are in church. What can we do to bring them back? Well, my experience suggests we simply wait and be open. Many who drift away as teenagers or young adults, once they start a family of their own, want their children to be part of the church, and so return to it themselves. If you are one of those, you are very welcome. Indeed, our welcoming of families is key to the future of our Church!

So Happy Mother's Day! Rejoice! I hope you all feel very welcome and at home in 'Mother' Church!

Paschal Triduum and Easter Services.

- Holy Thursday, March 28, when we commemorate the Last Supper and the giving of the Eucharist. Mass is at 8pm, followed by silent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament at the Altar of Repose until 10pm.
- Good Friday, March 29, the day of the suffering and death of Jesus on the Cross. The Liturgy of the Passion is at 3pm, the hour at which Our Lord died.
- Holy Saturday, March 30, our day of waiting at the tomb of Our Lord. The Easter Vigil begins at 7pm, at which we celebrate the resurrection and renew our baptismal promises.
- Easter Sunday, March 31, Mass is at 8.30am, 10am and 11.30am, (Sung Mass)

We will renew our baptismal promises at each Mass.
