We are doing a virtual Walking Tour Through the Bible, starting with the Book of Genesis, in bite size chunks. We are now doing the prophet Jeremiah. This Sunday is the feast of Corpus Christi, the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ our Lord. The prayers and readings are to be found in the yellow books on page 83. The first reading is from the Book of Deuteronomy in which Moses tells us the people how God fed them with manna, the bread from heaven, during their forty hard years in the wilderness on their way to the Promised Land. In the Gospel, from Saint John, Jesus tells us: 'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever: and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world.' Meditating on these words the Church has recognised the Eucharist as the Body and

Blood of Christ, truly His flesh and blood, and truly the Bread of Life and pledge of immortality. Moreover, we recognise in the Eucharist the real Presence of Christ the Lord, and we reverence the Eucharist as such.

This Sunday, there is Children's Liturgy at the 10am Mass.

Confirmation: This Sunday in the Hall at 7pm; the meeting lasts until 8.30pm. Let us pray for all our candidates and their families.

Last Sunday after the 11.30am Mass there was a chance to talk about the future of the Hove parishes in the Hall; there was a similar chance at the Social Club on Friday. There will be plenty more such opportunities. It is important that we all feel that the process of coming together is something we can all take part in. What emerged in the discussions is as follows:

- No to Project Fear and Project Gloom and yes to a forthright and joyful proclamation of the Catholic faith.
- Yes to evangelisation and to keeping our Church physically open as much as possible.
- A recognition that things will have to change due to declining clergy numbers and that we need more volunteers.

We will continue with these conversations as follows: After the 6pm Mass on Saturday 17 June; after the 8.30am Mass on Sunday 18 June, and after the 10am Mass on Sunday 25 June, all in the Hall.

Also this Monday: In the evening we are having the meeting of our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. We have had a few apologies, from people on holiday, but look forward to seeing many of you all there. The purpose of this meeting is to consider the upcoming changes in parish structure and how we ensure two things: first, that the housebound have communion, and second that the faithful receive Holy Communion under both kinds at Mass. A third objective is to recruit more EEMs.

Liturgical notes

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We shall be singing some of the hymns to the Sacred Heart. We are in Ordinary Time, which continues until Advent. On days on which there is no feast we shall celebrate a Votive Mass of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

- Tuesday is the feast of Saint Anthony of Padua, priest and doctor.
- Friday is the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Advance notice: Thursday 29 June is the feast of Saints Peter and Paul, a Holy Day of Obligation, and our patronal feast as well. There will be a Vigil Mass at 7:30pm on Wednesday 28 June at St Theresa's

(followed by adoration with simple Benediction at 8:30pm). There will be a morning Mass at 10am on Thursday at St George's in Hangleton. There will be Mass at noon at Sacred Heart. There will be an evening Mass here at 7pm, followed by a glass of wine in the Hall.

Confessions are after Mass on Friday morning, at 10.30am. On Saturday Confessions are heard before the evening Mass, at 5.15pm until 5.45pm.

Social dancing happens at 8pm in the Hall on Thursday; all are welcome. On Friday the Social club meets at 1.30pm. This Friday we shall be listening to Lovelynn Okwara give a talk on Nigeria. Please do join us if you can to what promises to be an interesting event.

From the writings of Fr James Martin SJ: This week we celebrate the Beautiful Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The main origins of the feast are with the visions received by St. Margaret Mary Alocoque, a 17th-century Visitation nun in a town called Paray-le-Monial, France. Her visions of Jesus presenting himself with his heart, were initially disbelieved by her fellow sisters. Then Jesus promised her in prayer that he would send her his "faithful servant and perfect friend." Shortly afterwards, a Jesuit named Claude la Colombiere showed up at the convent to serve as a spiritual director for the sisters. He saw that Sister Margaret Mary's visions were authentic, and devotion to the Sacred Heart spread from there.

Some people might be turned off by the devotion thanks to kitschy

representations of Jesus pulling open his cloak and pointing to his Sacred Heart. But if we set this devotion aside, we will miss out on a great opportunity to meditate on one of the most important aspects of Jesus's life: the way that he loved. The Sacred Heart is an invitation to ask ourselves, "How did Jesus love?" and "Whom did Jesus love?" For me the answers to those two questions are: abundantly, totally and completely; and everyone, especially those who were poor or marginalized. But there are other questions that **Solemnity of the Sacred Heart raises:** "How do I love?" and "Whom do I love?" And the most important question of all. "How can I love like Jesus?" Maybe that's a question you can ask yourself all week, as you encounter each person with the love of your own heart, which seeks to love as Jesus's Sacred Heart did.

This year marks the 150 anniversary of the opening of Arundel Cathedral. On Saturday 1 July at 12 noon there is going to be a Solemn High Mass to which all parishes have been invited to send two delegates. Our parish will be represented by Peter and Angela Fishenden.

The next First Holy Communion course starts on Saturday 16 September, and runs on each and every Saturday apart from the two Half Term Saturdays until Advent Sunday, 3 December, when the First Holy Communions take place. If you are interested, and places are limited, you need to sign up NOW. This is done by emailing Fr Alexander, who will send you the information; when you confirm your participation, your name will go on the list.
