Liturgical notes

Last Thursday, forty days after Easter, we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord. Next Sunday, 23 May, fifty days after Easter, is Pentecost, which closes the Easter season. The period in between the two feasts is the original nine days of prayer ('novena') of the Church imploring the gifts of the Holy Spirit. During this time, we shall be imploring the coming of the Holy Spirit by daily recitation at Mass of the Veni Creator. Please note the 'extra' Mass this Thursday coming. If you cannot come to Mass, do recite the Veni Creator at home.

The text is as follows:

Come, Holy Ghost, Creator, come from thy bright heav'nly throne; come, take possession of our souls, and make them all thine own.

Thou who art called the Paraclete, best gift of God above, the living spring, the living fire, sweet unction and true love.

Thou who art sevenfold in thy grace, finger of God's right hand; his promise, teaching little ones to speak and understand.

O guide our minds with thy blest light, with love our hearts inflame; and with thy strength, which ne'er decays, confirm our mortal frame.

Far from us drive our deadly foe; true peace unto us bring; and through all perils lead us safe beneath thy sacred wing.

Through thee may we the Father know, through thee th'eternal Son, and thee the Spirit of them both, thrice-blessed three in One.

All glory to the Father be, with his coequal Son; the same to thee, great Paraclete, while endless ages run.

Tuesday is the feast of Saint John I, pope and martyr Wednesday is the feast of Saint Dunstan, Archbishop of Canterbury and martyr.

Thursday is the feast of Saint Bernadine of Siena, priest.

Friday is the feast of Saint Christopher Magellanes and his companions, the Mexican martyrs.

Saturday is the feast of Saint Rita of Cascia, religious.

The month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin. Usually this month we try to sing hymns to Our Lady, but with Covid restrictions still in place this will not be possible. The Pope has asked all Catholics to recite the Rosary for the intention of the end of the pandemic. We will do so after every weekday Mass on which there is no funeral. Those who do not like communal recitation of the Rosary are warmly invited to pray the Rosary at home.

We have heard the sad news of the death of Jim McFarlane, who died at the Martlets Hospice on Tuesday 11 May. Let us pray for the repose of his soul, and the comfort of his widow Dolores and their family. Details of Jim's funeral will be announced when known.

Of our target of £30,000 for the Hall restoration fund, we have raised the further sum of £219.30 which brings our total to £6,360.42 so far. Many thanks to Mary and Mary for their superb offer of Fish and Chips in return for a £5 donation, plus other things sold at the shop at 6, Boundary Road. And may thanks to Armanda for her foot-doctoring for £25, which had raised £100 so far. Work on the Hall has now begun, and will last until August. Please do not go into the Hall, and please advise young children of this, for health and safety reasons. In addition, please note that the Presbytery driveway is occupied and not free for parking. With the Hall closed, the only loo available is on the ground floor of the presbytery approachable via the outer

sacristy. You may like to ask the stewards about access if you do not know where this is.

Fundraiser Number Three: Are your feet killing you? Relief is at hand! Armanda Christides is offering a full podiatric treatment, usually worth £40, to all comers for a mere £25 donation to the Hall refurbishment fund. Please buy a ticket in the sacristy, and then make your appointment with Armanda our parish foot doctor/beauty therapist.

We are collecting donations for the Food Bank. Please leave your donation in the tub inside the door of the Outer Sacristy. If locked, by the door.

The Care Group is meeting on Tuesday 18 May. The purpose of this group is to organise the parish's care of those who are stuck at home or those who are in any type of need. This matter is particularly pressing thanks to the challenges imposed by lockdown. One of the things that we aim to set up in the new Hall is a bereavement group and this is something we wish to discuss. If there is anything else we should be looking at, or you wish to get involved with, please just say.

From May 17 gatherings out of doors up to a certain number are allowed. This means we can have coffee on the pavement after the 10am Mass, and indeed after the 11.15am Mass, on Sundays. We have some volunteers who would like to activate this; but if you would like to get involved, please say so. If we solicit donations for coffee and perhaps other things too (biscuits etc) these could be for the Hall refurbishment. In addition, the sight of happy people

enjoying the sunshine (!) after Mass is a good advertisement for the parish.

Our next baptism class will be on Monday 14 June at 8pm. Because the Hall is out of use, it will take place in the Church. If you have a baby to baptise, then you need to see Father Alexander before enrolling on the course, and he will come and visit you at home.

We do not have any Bidding Prayers at Mass any more, but people have suggested we pray for certain intentions, among which are:

- Political prisoners in Hong Kong, especially Jimmy Lai.
- The people of India, facing a dire Covid crisis, and the various nations around the world which do not have an adequate supply of vaccines.
- The sick of the parish, and all those who are looking after them.
- All students facing exams at this time of years, all who are teaching them, and their families.
- All people who are facing hardship and unemployment thanks to the pandemic. If you have any prayer intentions you would like to bring to the notice of the parish, please email them in, or submit them in writing.

Those Covid Rules:

- The capacity of the church is 100 people: two people per bench, spaced at one metre apart, and one person per chair. (Families can sit together.) Please spread out as widely as possible and do not bunch together.
- Please check in for track and trace purposes, either electronically or in writing.
- Please sanitise your hands on entry and exit.
- Please observe the one way system: up the middle, down the sides, especially at Holy Communion.
- If you take a newsletter, please take it home with you.
- There is STILL no congregational singing.
- The Church doors are to remain open to ventilate the building.
- Mass is shorter than usual.
- There is no procession of the Gifts to the altar and no passing around of the collection baskets. Your offering will be taken as you leave the Church.
- There is no sign of peace.
- Holy Communion will be received under one kind only.
- Communion must be given silently, avoiding any physical contact.
- Please remove your mask (if wearing one) and gloves to receive Holy Communion.
- As you leave do not to linger in doorways or other 'choke points'.
- Once Mass is over the Church will be closed and cleaned.
- People are urged not to come to the sacristy before and after Mass, unless they are servers or sacristans.

- Face coverings are mandatory for all who are not exempt.
- The Bishops also urge readers to wear disposable gloves.

We are getting lots of passport forms and other forms to sign. Aisling has kindly taken this on. Please note that forms should be dropped off in office hours only, and all the details need to be filled in before submission for signature or counter-signature and stamping. They will then be handed back to you also during office hours. within a reasonable time. It is not possible to offer a while you wait service. Neither is it possible to countersign identity papers for people who one does not know. With regard to baptism and confirmation certificates. requests are best submitted in writing. with a stamped addressed envelope. Please remember to include as much information as possible, as this makes tracking down the records easier. Dealing with forms does take time, and the parish does not charge for this service, but craves your patience.
