Liturgical notes

The month of September is dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady. The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows occurs on 15 September. We are in Ordinary Time, which continues until Advent. On days on which there is no feast we shall celebrate a Votive Mass of Our Lady.

The Seven Sorrows are:

- 1. The Prophecy of Simeon, in Luke 2.
- 2. The Flight into Egypt, in Matthew 2
- 3. The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem, also in Luke 2
- 4. Mary meeting Jesus on the Via Dolorosa, the Fourth station of the Cross which is not found in Bible.
- The Crucifixion of Jesus on Mount Calvary, the Eleventh Station of the Cross, in Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, and especially John 19

- 6. Jesus's Descent from the Cross, the Thirteeenth Station of the Cross, in Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, and John 19.
- 7. The Burial of Jesus by Joseph of Arimathea, the Fourteenth Station of the Cross, in Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, and John 19.

Confessions are heard after Mass on Friday morning, at 10.30am. On Saturday Confessions are heard before the evening Mass, at 5.15pm until 5.45pm.

Tuesday is the feast of Saint Januarius, bishop and martyr. Mass is at 11am and is the funeral Mass of Peter Cloherty RIP.

Wednesday is the feast of Saint Andrew Kim Taegon and his companions, the martyrs of Korea.

The next baptism course will take place in the Hall on Monday 9th October at 8pm. If you have a baby to baptise, please get in touch with Fr Alexander via email before then.

On Monday 11th September, at 8pm in the hall at Saint George's, the Hove parishes core teams met. The purpose of the meeting was to prepare for the unification of the Hove parishes. Several important decisions were made, to whit:

- A sub-committee has been formed to look at re-ordering the times of Mass in Hove, which will report back before the second week of October, when the priests of the Deanery meet.
- A sub-committee has been formed to look at producing a single newsletter for all the Hove parishes, and a single Facebook page and Twitter stream.
- A group will convene to consider a single baptism course for the Hove parishes.

Another thing that was on the table was the proposal that soon we should have only one Saturday evening Mass in Hove instead of three.

Thursday 12th October is a special day for our parish as it is the feast of the Blessed Carlo Acutis. As we are home to his shrine, we are the only Church in the diocese where his feast is celebrated. This year Bishop Richard will celebrate the Mass,
