This Sunday is the Third Sunday of

The Gospel, from Saint Luke, is the story of the appearance of Jesus to two disciples on the road to Emmaus on the evening of Easter Sunday.

The Coronation. The diocese has suggested the following to us, namely that we hold a Triduum of Prayer (from Wednesday 3 to Friday 5 May) to pray for the King as he assumes the fullness of his responsibility. In addition, on Friday evening, 5 May, a Mass for the intentions of the King should be celebrated. We have been sent the liturgical texts and the suggested readings for this Mass. On Sunday 7 May, the day after the Coronation, a Prayer of Intercession for the King should be included in the Prayer of the Faithful along with the option for singing the Domine, salvum fac in English or Latin. It will also be appropriate to sing the National Anthem at the end of Mass. prior to the Recession. Prayer cards for this occasion will be printed and distributed directly to parishes from the Bishops' Conference Secretariat. Naturally, we are very happy to go along with all these suggestions!

Please note the two following points which are very important. No one is to adjust or tamper with the settings of the microphones. The only person authorised to touch the controls of the microphones is Adrian Reeve.
