This Sunday is the Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The prayers and readings are to be found in the yellow books on page 131. The first reading is from the prophecy of Isaiah, in which we are exhorted to seek the Lord, who is transcendent, that is, high above us, which is precisely why we need to seek him. In the Gospel, from Saint Matthew, Jesus recounts the parable of the vineyard workers: those who are hired late in the day receive the same reward as those who have worked long and hard all day. God is generous in His rewards to those He calls. and His generosity cannot be measured by human standards, but goes beyond them.

This Sunday, there is Children's Liturgy at the 10am Mass.

The month of September is dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady. The month of October, which begins next week, is dedicated to the Rosary and to prayer for the Missions. In October we will try to say the Rosary after every weekday Mass which is not a funeral. On days on which there is no feast we shall celebrate one of the Masses for the spread of the Gospel.

Confessions are heard after Mass on Friday morning, at 10.30am. On Saturday Confessions are heard before the evening Mass, at 5.15pm until 5.45pm.

- Monday is the feast of the Holy Guardian Angels.
- Tuesday is the feast of the Blessed Martyrs of Sussex.
- Wednesday is the feast of Saint Francis of Assisi.
- Friday is the feast of Saint Bruno.

We have heard the sad news of the death of Michael Patrick Mulpeter, who died on Sunday, 10th September 2023 in the Royal Sussex County Hospital aged 86 years. His funeral Mass will take place here on Monday 9th October at 11am Mass, to be followed by cremation at Woodvale South Chapel at 12:30pm. This will replace the 10am Mass on that day. Let us pray for Michael's soul and the comfort of his family at this sad and difficult time for them.

Repeated from last week: On Monday 11th September, at 8pm in the hall at Saint George's, the Hove parishes core teams met. The purpose of the meeting was to prepare for the unification of the Hove parishes. Several important decisions were made, to whit:
