

This Sunday is the feast of Christ the King and the Last Sunday in Ordinary

Time. The prayers and readings are to be found in the yellow books on page 158. The first reading is from the Prophet Ezekiel, in which the Lord explains He will pasture his sheep and judge between them and the goats. In the Gospel, from Saint Matthew, Jesus describes the Last Judgement, and how the Lord will separate sheep from goats, and how the criterion of judgement will be whether we kept the law of charity to our neighbour. It is in this parable we meet the things that develop into the list of the seven works of corporal mercy, namely: To feed the hungry, to give drink to the thirsty, to clothe the naked, to shelter the homeless, to visit the sick, to visit the imprisoned, and to bury the dead.

Today, instead of a sermon, there will be a Pastoral Letter from Bishop Richard.

As we all know, the situation in Syria, though not making headlines, is not good. If you have any NEW goods to donate, please do so; there will also be things like cake and home produce.

Sunday 17th December; as in the past, we should aim to invite as many people as possible to come to this, as it is a thing that many non-religious people seem to enjoy and like. In the past we have had a retiring collection for some charitable endeavour. Perhaps this year we should make it for Aid to the Church in Need, as with the stall the previous Sunday?

As noted before, Christmas day fall on a Monday this year and Christmas Eve is a

Sunday. To avoid confusion, all the Sunday Masses on 23rd and 24th December will be at the usual times, though there will be no music or little music (possibly some unaccompanied hymns, but no choir, organ or other accompaniment.) There will be, as usual, five Christmas Masses: 6pm Vigil, 12 Midnight, 8.30am Dawn, and 10am and 11.30am Day. All will have music bar the Dawn Mass. We have heard the sad news, and yet happy news too, that Veronica Hope has completed her earthly journey. She died on the morning of 21st November, at the age of 100 and 7 months, in the Lindridge Nursing Home. The previous afternoon she had received the Commendation of the Dying and the Apostolic Pardon. She had had received the Sacrament of the Sick sometime previously. Her funeral arrangements will be announced in due course.

We have heard the sad news of the death of Robert Koenig which happened

at The Pines Nursing home on 14th November. Robert was aged 72, and had received the Sacrament of the Sick some weeks ago from Fr Alexander. His funeral Mass will take place here on Wednesday 6th December at 11.00am to be followed by burial in Hove Cemetery. Let us pray for his widow Regina and his two sons and his wider family at this sad and difficult time for them, and for the repose of his soul.

The funeral of Doris Mitchell RIP will take place here on Friday 8th December.

The coffin will arrive in Church at 9.45am. Because that day is a solemn feast, Mass at 10am will be the Mass of the Immaculate Conception, and Doris's funeral will take place immediately afterwards at 10.45am, to be followed by burial at Portslade Cemetery.


