This Sunday is Pentecost. The prayers and readings are to be found in the yellow books on pages 280/285/286 for the Vigil Mass, and page 288 for the Mass on Sunday morning. The first reading on Sunday morning, from the Acts of the Apostles, tells us of the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples of Our Lord in the Upper Room, fifty days after Easter and ten days after the Ascension. In the Gospel, from Saint John, Jesus appears to the disciples on the evening of Easter day and gives them the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins. This, along with the gift of peace, underlines the Church's mission to reconcile human beings to

God. Jesus also shows His disciples the wounds He sustained in His passion. which again emphasises the atonement He has affected between us and God. Pentecost is the third most important feast of the Christian year, and brings Eastertide to a close.

This Sunday, there is Children's Liturgy at the 10am Mass.
