

This Sunday is the Thirty-First Sunday

in Ordinary Time. The prayers and readings are to be found in the yellow books on page 149. The first reading is from the prophet Malachi, in which the Lord upbraids and reproves the priests in the Temple, for not keeping the Covenant. In the Gospel, from Saint Matthew, Jesus rebukes the Pharisees for their selfimportant behaviour and the way they make life hard for the faithful of Israel. In contrast to both these passages, in the second reading, Saint Paul, writing to the church in Thessaloniki, speaks of his flock in these words: 'Like a mother feeding and looking after her own children, we felt so devoted and protective towards you, and had come to love you so much, that we were eager to hand over to you not only the Good News but our whole lives as well.' It is clear from this that Saint Paul was a model pastor to his flock.

This Sunday there is Children's Liturgy at the 10am Mass.

This Sunday there is a collection for the Retired Priest's Fund as you leave the Church. As the name suggests this goes to help maintain those diocesan priests who are retired. (The usual retirement age for priests is 75.) There is a notice on the board at the back of the Church about the diocesan charity that has been set up to help retired priests, if you wish to donate directly to that as well.

Liturgical notes

The month of November is dedicated to prayer for the faithful departed. On days when there is no feast, we will be celebrating the daily Mass for the Dead. Let us devote ourselves assiduously to this intention.

Friday is the feast of Saint Leo the Great, pope and doctor of the Church.

On Sat, 11th Nov, the Vigil Mass at 6pm will be a Requiem Mass for All the Dead of War, for Remembrance Sunday. The morning Masses will be the Mass of the Thirty-Second Sunday of the Year.

Brace yourselves! Advent is coming, and though not as penitential as Lent, is still a penitential season. This year it starts on Sunday 3rd Dec, and is the shortest it can be, just over three weeks in which to prepare for Christmas. We plan to celebrate three Rorate Masses by candle light on Tues in Advent at 7am. They begin in total darkness and end as dawn breaks. Afterwards we shall have a power breakfast at Scottie's.
