We have heard the sad news of the death of Father Mario Sanderson on Monday 16 August at Holy Cross Care Home. Details of the funeral arrangements will be sent out as and when they are known. Meanwhile, let us pray for the eternal rest of his soul. Father Mario was, some years ago, parish priest of the Sacred Heart in Hove.

Our running total of funds raised for the Hall is now £14,952.71. This includes the sum of £144.20 from the sale of cakes and other delicious things after Mass last Sunday. The hall is nearing completion, but no date can be set for this as yet. Many thanks to all who have donated and helped in so many ways! You are all being remembered at the Mass we offer for our Benefactors.

Liturgical notes

The month of September is dedicated to the Holy Angels and on days when there is no feast we shall celebrate the Votive Mass of the Angels. Wednesday 8 September is the feast of the nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Next year, the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth will celebrate The Queen's 70th anniversary, her Platinum Jubilee - the first time any British monarch has reached this historic milestone. There will be various celebrations across the country, culminating in a four day holiday from Thursday 2 June to Sunday 5 June inclusive. This is still some way off, but it is important that we begin to think of what we

want to do to mark this national celebration which the children in our parish will undoubtedly remember for years. It would be a great shame for Saint Peter's not to take part, and to miss being a focus of festivity in the community. In addition, we are an international community and it is worth celebrating the way the United Kingdom is home to so many people of differing origin, all united in living here and enjoying it too. The Platinum Jubilee celebrations will undoubtedly reflect this at national level, but we need to mark this at local level too. To this end, it is proposed to set up an Action Committee to look at what we can do.

Cardinal Burke is recovering from Covid, and send this message to all of us who prayed for him (the full message can be found on line): 'In the Sacred Heart of Jesus and through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I express deep gratitude to God, who has brought me to this point of healing and recovery.

As previously communicated by the leadership and staff of the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, for whom I also express my profound appreciation, I am no longer intubated with a medical ventilator. I have been transferred out of the Medical Intensive Care Unit and settled in a hospital room where the doctors, nurses, and numerous hospital staff have provided vigilant, superb, and steadfast medical care. For these dedicated professionals, too, I offer heartfelt thanks, as well as to the priests who have ministered to me sacramentally. To those who have offered innumerable Rosaries and prayers, lighted candles, and requested the offering of the Holy Mass, I extend my sincere gratitude, and I ask the Lord and His Mother to bless you all. I also thank my brother bishops

and priests who have offered Mass for me or prayed for me at the altar.'

It is now time for us to resume a few more things that have been discontinued over the pandemic. Aisling is in the office and building up the readers' rotas and those for Eucharistic ministers (the latter are not so pressing as Holy Communion remains under one kind for now.) Please email her with your availability if you have not done so already. And please email her with same if you are invited to become a reader, which is a very important ministry in the Church. We also need to return to the custom of readers and ministers gathering in the sacristy ten minutes before Mass for prayers.

The care Group is meeting on Monday 13 September. This is the group that concerns itself with the sick, the housebound and others in any type of need. At present, at long last, visitors are now allowed in nursing and residential homes, subject to certain conditions, such as making an appointment and have a lateral flow test for Covid. This means that several of our parishioners have now been visited after a considerable interval. As mentioned before, we need to know about the sick and housebound if we are to visit them; so if anyone is at home or in a nursing home and wishes to be visited, please pass this news on.

On 12 September, we pray that God will fortify those working to make our schools & colleges places of learning and sanctuary – not just teachers and leaders but all the support staff whose tireless work sometimes goes unnoticed.
