

Meeting with Bishop Richard

At our meeting on Monday night Kate Williamson gave a very helpful short talk on what it means to be Baptised and the call given to all baptised to be the bearers of Good News. We went on to discuss the future of our region keeping in mind that Pastoral regions (Parishes) will be much larger in the future as the number of priests dwindle. We were also reminded that this is not a time to be afraid but a time of opportunity. The Scripture passage we reflected on reminded all of us of the "variety of gifts given to us for a good purpose". We also reflected on the following question and we ask you to give it some consideration. If Bishop Richard came to St. Peter's and said "I cannot find a priest for Southwick/Portslade/St. Georges, Sacred Heart". So from the 1st of May your Pastoral Region (Parish) will be all of Hove/Portslade/Southwick (Don't worry Parishioners from Southwick/Sacred Heart, we have no intention yet of expanding). If it happened and it may in time how would we manage to care for the people with just one priest? What help are you able to give as a baptised member of that Pastoral

Then on Wednesday we met with Bishop Richard and other representatives from the different Parishes of the Deanery. Reports from Parishes were similar. I have heard most of them many times over the past 50 years. No great decisions were taken but we all left with the desire and challenge to encourage people to play a more active part in the life of our Parishes.

Seeing your life through the lens of the Gospel

This passage contains three stories and there is food for thought in each of them.

- 1. The first is one of healing. You might reflect on a time when you were sick in mind, body or spirit and someone who helped take care of you. Remember them with gratitude.
- 2. The second story adds another dimension. People freed from demons. We can find ourselves imprisoned by fear, anxiety, guilt, low self-esteem, addictions, bitterness,
- 3. The third story has a number of different elements to consider. Jesus goes to a desert place after a busy day, He felt the need to for quiet, to ground himself once more. In the rough and tumble of daily life how do you keep in touch with what is going on inside yourself? What difference does it make if you take time out?
