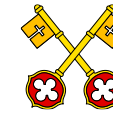

### Fr. Bryan Storey

Died on Wednesday in Tintagel where he served as a priest for the past 30 years. Some of our older Parishioners will remember him as a priest here in St. Peter's from 1960 to 1971. He was much loved by the people of St. Peter's and many of them still speak warmly about him. May he rest in peace. Funeral arrangements later.

### Changes at St. Peter's

I will leave this note in for another week as some people may have been away on holiday. I know it came as a bit of a shock but I had been hinting at it for some time. When priests are approaching the age of 75 they are expected to write to the Bishop saying they are willing to retire. I wrote to Bishop Richard last March and after a discussion with him felt it was time for me to retire from St. Peter's and appoint a new Parish priest. It wasn't an easy decision but with new challenges facing Parishes I realise I haven't got the energy that the Parish needs to move forward and implement the plan Bishop Richard will produce in the Autumn. I feel a bit like St Paul " *I have run the race to the finish and the time has come for me to be gone.*

**Bishop Richard** has appointed a much younger more energetic priest **Fr. Alexander Lucie-Smith** who at the present time is Parish Priest in Knaphill near Woking. He will arrive here at the end of September. Google will give you some information on Fr. Alexander.

**What will I do?** I won't find it that easy to move having worked here for 18 years where I have been greatly supported by you the Parishioners. I would be very happy to live in the Brighton region but I think it is better to move further afield and help as a supply priest in different parts of the Diocese. A flat belonging to the Diocese will become available in Hershaw (not Horsham) near Walton on Thames and I will probably move in there. It is an hours' drive from Brighton but I know quite a number of people in that region as I have been a priest in Walton and West Byfleet.

Fr. Alexander has been down to meet with me and he is very pleased to be coming to St. Peter's.

He will be away on holiday for most of September so he decided to come for the last weekend in September. He is a very able young man and I'm sure you will give him all the support he needs for this wonderful Parish.
