

1. The story reminds us of how personal prejudices and agendas can block us from listening to the content of what another person is saying, no matter how relevant or wise it is. Perhaps you've experienced this, what difference does it make when vou were able to focus on the content of what was being said and leave aside your own prejudices about the speaker? 2. Its been said that there is nothing as useless as the right advice at the wrong time. We may want to reach out to another, but may be unable to make a useful contribution because at that moment the other person is not ready to be helped. As Jesus had to be patient and wait for another opportunity so do we. 3. The topic of religion can easily bring up prejudices. leading some to dismiss religion as superstition, old hat, or based on an outdated world view. Even among believers, prejudice can make it hard for individuals to listen to an alternative way of looking at things, to consider a different way of celebrating liturgy, or to live at peace with difference. Yet a closed mind can lead to a stagnant faith.
