This Sunday is the Fifth Sunday of Easter. The first reading is an account of the end of Saint Paul's first missionary journey in which he tells the new Christian converts: 'We all have to experience many hardships before we enter the kingdom of God.' Moreover, we are told that this was Saint Paul's way of putting fresh heart into his flock. In the Gospel, we are reminded of

Jesus' foremost commandment, that we love each other, to the same extent, as he has loved us.

Confessions are heard every Saturday morning, from 10.30 to 11.15am.

It was good to see so many enjoying the film and pizza last Saturday. It is proposed to hold the next film night on Saturday 3 August, given that summer is always a quiet time. Because last Saturday was sunny, there was a lot of light coming in from the main window of the Hall, and we may have to do something to block that. The film is still to be decided – suggestions welcome – but please note the date now and invite all your friends to come along too.

Meanwhile we have the family film to look forward to, next Sunday 26 May at 6pm. The film is Night at the Museum I, and pizza and soft drinks will be served at half time. The purpose of his visit was to burnish ties between the parish and the school and raise awareness of the school in the parish, and his talk certainly helped do both. There will be no 10am Mass on this day, and no scheduled confessions.

The funeral of Margaret Kelsey, who died in Saint Mary's Care Home, Preston Park, on Sunday 5 May, will take place on Wednesday 29 May at 12 noon. The celebrant will be Fr John Collins, who is chaplain to Saint Mary's. This coincides with the Diocesan clergy in service training days, and there will be no 10am Mass on that day. Let us continue to pray for the repose of Margaret's soul and the comfort of her family.

We are unveiling the new stained glass on Saturday 1st June at the 6pm Vigil Mass. All are invited to this and to drinks in the Hall afterwards. Fr Jerry will be present. The glass has been installed, and looks very good, but has been covered up until its official unveiling.

We have received several copies of *The Evangelist*, the magazine of Saint John's Seminary. They are free, so please take a copy if interested, and bring it back later so others can read it as well.

Liturgical Notes: We are now in the month of May, which is specially dedicated to Our Lady. During this month we should aim to sing more of the traditional hymns to the Blessed Virgin and to pray the Rosary more. To this end, after the weekday Mass, when there is no Exposition, we shall recite the Rosary communally. In addition, we can all say the Rosary at home.

Monday is the feast of Saint Bernadine of Siena.
Tuesday is the feast of Saint Christopher Magellanes and his companions, the martyrs of Mexico.
Wednesday is the feast of Saint Rita of Cascia.
Saturday is the feast of Saint Bede the Venerable.

Thursday 30 May is the Solemnity of the Ascension, which has now been restored to its rightful day, 40 days after Easter. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, when the faithful are bound to attend Mass under pain of sin. Please note the date now. We shall have Mass at 10am on Thursday morning, and at 7.30pm in the evening. The nine days that follow, leading up to Pentecost, are the nine days of prayer that the apostles spent with Our Lady awaiting the coming of the Holy Spirit: the original novena. We shall be keeping this novena by reciting or singing the Come Holy Spirit daily.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Exposed takes place here every Friday

after the 10am Mass for 30 minutes. With transforming mercy, Jesus makes our heart one with his. "He proposes his own example to those who come to him, that all may learn to be like himself, gentle and humble of heart, and to seek not their own interest but those of God." (Pope Paul VI, *Mysterium Fidei*)
