**This Sunday is the Sixth Sunday of Easter.** The first reading tells us of a challenge to the early Church: were new converts to Christianity, who had never been Jewish, obliged to keep the Jewish law when they became Christians? This question was settled by the meeting known as the Council of Jerusalem, which decided that they did not. The wording of the decision is important: 'It has been decided by the Holy Spirit and ourselves...' we read. Again, in the Gospel, Jesus speaks of the sending of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, 'who will teach you everything and remind you of all that I have said to you.' We believe that the Church is the Body of Christ and is given life by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, which protects the Church from teaching error, and guides the Church, through discernment, when difficult decisions have to be made. Needless to say, the Church's teaching on 'new' questions cannot contradict the teaching received from Jesus, but must be in continuity with it. Church teaching grows and develops, but it does not change.

**This Sunday there is a retiring collection for the missionary endeavour of the diocese.**

Confessions are heard every Saturday morning, from 10.30 to 11.15am.

This Sunday, 26 May, our family film night begins at 6pm. The film is Night at the Museum I, and pizza and soft drinks will be served at half time. The evening should end shortly after 8pm. All are welcome. Younger viewers are urged to bring bean bags to sit on. Parents who wish to drop children off and collect them later are free to do so, as long as they leave contact details. Parents and others who want to stay are also welcome!

This week there is no Mass on Tuesday morning, as Fr Alexander will be travelling to the clergy in service training. Moreover, Mass on Wednesday is at 12 noon and will be the funeral of Margaret Kelsey, who died in Saint Mary's Care Home, Preston Park, on Sunday 5 May. The celebrant will be Fr John Collins, who is chaplain to Saint Mary's. In addition, there will be two Masses on Thursday 30 May at 10am and at 7.30pm, as it is the Solemnity of the Ascension, which has now been restored to its rightful day, 40 days after Easter. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, when the faithful are bound to attend Mass under pain of sin.

We are unveiling the new stained glass in this Saturday, 1 June, at the 6pm Vigil Mass. All are invited to this and to drinks in the Hall afterwards. Fr Jerry will be the principle celebrant and will preach; we hope Fr Kevin Dring will also be there, as will several other invited guests.

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Anne (Tiny) Lloyd, who was a parishioner at St Peter's for several years, and who died unexpectedly in her sleep on Sunday 12th May. She was 66 years old. Her funeral will be on Wednesday 12th June at 12 noon at St Mary Magdalen's Church.

**Liturgical Notes:** We are now coming to the end of the month of May, which is specially dedicated to Our Lady. June, which follows is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. There are several beautiful hymns specifically to the Sacred Heart which we shall aim to sing. In addition, there are lots of hymns the treat of God's love for us in Jesus, which we will be singing too.

Monday is the feast of Saint Augustine of Canterbury, bishop.

Tuesday is the feast of the Blessed Margaret Pole, martyr.

Thursday is the solemnity of the Ascension. The nine days that follow, leading up to Pentecost, are the nine days of prayer that the apostles spent with Our Lady awaiting the coming of the Holy Spirit: the original novena. We shall be keeping this novena by reciting or singing the Come Holy Spirit daily.

Friday is the feast of the Visitation of Our Lady.

Saturday is the feast of Saint Justin, martyr.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Exposed takes place here every Friday after the 10am Mass for 30 minutes. If the Pope himself would give you a special invitation to visit him in the Vatican, this honour would be nothing in comparison to the honour and dignity that Jesus himself bestows upon you with the invitation of spending one hour with him in the Blessed Sacrament. "The divine Eucharist bestows upon the Christian people the incomparable dignity." (Pope Paul VI, *Mysterium Fidei*)
