

# Seeing through the Lens of the Gospel

- 1. 'The Lord is my Shepherd'. How often have we sung this Psalm heard it read and repeated in response? Its words are so familiar to us that we might not think about what we are saying. The image of Jesus as a shepherd is worth reflecting on, especially on this Good Shepherd Sunday.

  2. Four years ago on Holy Thursday
- Pope Francis caused a bit of a stir when he urged bishops and priests to get to know their flocks and to be like shepherds who 'smell of their sheep': 'This I ask you: be shepherds, with the 'odour of the sheep', make it real, as shepherds among your flock.' The vivid image captured the imagination of many who heard it. But in evoking this metaphor, Pope Francis was echoing the language of the Gospel extract we hear today.
- 3. Jesus tells us that sheep recognise the voice of their shepherd and follow him. This kind of trust can only be gained by a shepherd who protects and feeds them well. That is how well Jesus knows us and gave himself for us.
