Confessions next Saturday

At 10.30am

This Sunday is the 32nd Sunday of the Year. In both readings today we meet widows. In the first reading, the prophet Elijah is taken in by a poor widow on the brink of starvation, who is suitably rewarded by God for her kindness and generosity to a stranger. In the Gospel, Jesus commends the poor widow who he sees putting two pennies into the Temple treasury, which is all that she had to live on. This reminds us of Mother Teresa's dictum: "Give until it hurts." Real charity requires sacrifice and dedication. It has to come from the heart and to cost us something.

This Sunday is also Remembrance Sunday. The 11.15am Mass today will be a Mass of Requiem for the War Dead. This Mass will mark to the day and hour the hundredth anniversary of the end of the First World War. As it is a requiem, there will be no Gloria.

This Sunday at 4pm, we shall have Vespers for the Dead followed by Rosary. The Office does not take long, and the Rosary is an excellent way to pray for the faithful departed and for peace in the world. Do please come along. The combined Rosary and Office will not take more than half an hour. 'At the going down of the sun we shall remember them'. We have more books on order, so, this week, one hopes, everyone will have a book.

Liturgical Notes:

In November, when there is no feast day, we shall celebrate the daily Mass for the dead, provided the Mass intention is for a deceased person; that is to say that we shall celebrate the Mass in the Missal designated 'for several deceased persons or for all the dead.'

On Monday 12th November the 10am Mass will be the funeral of Joan McKee, who died on 3rd November. Joan was a parishioner here for many years and was known to many in the parish. The Funeral Mass will be followed by committal at Woodvale Crematorium. Let us pray for the repose of Joan's soul and the comfort of her family.

On Tuesday 13th November there is Mass for the deceased clergy of the deanery at Sacred

Heart at 11am. All the deanery priests will be concelebrating. This is an annual event to which all are invited. Among those remembered will be all deceased past parish clergy of this parish, naturally. On that day, please note, there will be no 10am Mass here.

Saturday is the feast of Saint Hugh of Lincoln.

On Sunday 18th November, Father Ephraim, of the Syriac Orthodox Church, is coming to our parish Church at our invitation to celebrate the Divine Liturgy for members of his community. The Syriac Orthodox Church is under the authority of the Orthodox Patriarch of Antioch, and in communion with the Patriarch of Constantinople. There are many Syrians living in Hove who are members of the Syriac Orthodox Church. This is a rare opportunity for us to witness the Eastern Liturgy at first hand, so do come along if you wish. The Divine Liturgy will start at 5pm and last approximately an hour and half. Afterwards the Hall will be available.
