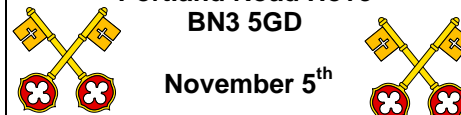

Some may have very important appointments every Sat eve but probably not. One priest said they probably don’t like the final blessing. Generally at all other Masses people stay right to the end and greet one another. It makes no difference what time Mass finishes, the back 3 or 4 seats of our Church are empty when we process out. Anyway don’t get too stressed with this comment and remember you are all welcome whatever time you come or go. But the final words at the end of Mass are important “**Go in peace and glorify the Lord with your life**”.
