

Planning for the future

Bishop Richard came to our Deanery last week to give a presentation in the hope of getting all of us to focus on the mission entrusted to us. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations" He is calling on us to think "Diocese" rather than Parish which is very difficult to do as most of us are generally just concerned with our own patch. At the moment we have just under 100 active priests in the Diocese but by 2030 we will have less than 50. There is a danger that we focus too much on the provision of Mass and the number of Masses in any given region. Certainly the Mass must be at the heart of any Christian community and we are only a Christian community if the Eucharist is at the heart of that community and we need a priest for the Eucharist. But keeping that in mind a priest spends far less time celebrating Mass and much more ministering to the needs of sick, schools, housebound, hospitals. We will have an open meeting in the Parish later in the year when we can try to focus our minds on the mission entrusted to us
