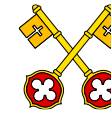

Confessions next Saturday

At 10.30am

Fr Alexander will be inducted as Parish Priest by Bishop Richard on Saturday at the 6pm Mass, you are all invited to attend.

This Sunday is the 26th Sunday of the Year, and the readings tell us something about the charismatic nature of the Church – that is to say that the whole Church has been anointed with the Holy Spirit and can exercise the gifts or charisms of the Holy Spirit. This Sunday is thus a day on which we can think back to our baptism and our confirmation, when we were invested with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. In the first reading Moses teaches that God wants all His people to be filled with the Spirit of the Lord; and in the Gospel, the message is the same: God gives His gifts generously, and He wishes His Spirit to fill and transform the world.

Liturgical Notes:

This coming week it is goodbye to September, which is the month dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady, and it is hello to the month of October, which is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. In fact, we are allowed to celebrate one mass of the Holy Rosary next Sunday, as it is the feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary this coming Saturday. We shall do this at the 6pm Mass (the readings, please note, will be for the 27th Sunday). The Church encourages us throughout October not just to think about the Rosary but to pray it regularly! In addition, October is also the month of prayer for the Missions.

Monday is the feast of the St Therese of Lisieux.

Tuesday is the feast of Holy Guardian Angels.

Wednesday is the feast of the Blessed Martyrs of Sussex

Thursday is the feast of St Francis of Assisi.

Friday is the first Friday of the month.

Saturday is the feast of St Bruno.

Parish Pastoral Plan

Bishop Richard presented the Pastoral plan for the Diocese to all of us last Tuesday. There isn't room in the Newsletter to outline the main points

of the plan. We can expect some changes as the projected number of active priests in the Diocese in 12 years time will be roughly half the number we now have. Bishop Richard will present the plan to Deanery at Cardinal Newman School on Thursday eve 11th October at 7pm.

We have a Saint Peter's Facebook group. If you are on Facebook, please search for "St Peter's, Hove" and ask to join the group. All parishioners and spouses of parishioners are welcome to join. The idea is for the Facebook group to be an electronic noticeboard for the parish and a place where questions can be asked, and, one hopes, answers given. We have also set up a Twitter account. This will in due course appear on the front page of our website. The idea is that this twitter stream will be a place to make short announcements, such as what feast day it is, and similar things.
