### **Fifteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time**

When Jesus sends out the Twelve in pairs his message is clear. They will have his authority over unclean spirits, they are not to take too much with them, and minister in places they are welcomed. The ministry takes the following shape, they preach repentance, cast out devils and anoint the sick. Over the next few years we have been given the shape of our ministry in the Diocesan Pastoral Plan. I mention this as something for us to gently chew over during the summer months so that when we come back for the 'new term' in the Autumn we might be able to view things in this light.

Here is the key paragraph from the plan: "The principles of Prayer, Formation and Mission must be the measure against which we place every endeavour. Prayer is the vital prerequisite for every conversation, every thought and action. Formation in every aspect of Faith is necessary if we are to be effective in Mission. Mission calls us outward, beyond the safety of that with which we are comfortable..." The three principles of prayer, mission, formation will take a different shape in each of the Catholic communities across the city. So with prayer some communities may focus on Eucharistic Adoration, some the Prayer of the Church, others the Rosary. With Formation, some may go more deeply into the understanding of the liturgy, others social teaching or catechesis. Mission may take people out to social action, or helping others to understand Jesus better or working with young families, those who are older or other groups.

We take our part in prayer, formation and mission to be able share in the work that is so beautifully set out in our second reading: "He has let us know the mystery of his purpose, the hidden plan he so kindly made in Christ from the beginning to act upon when the times had run their course to the end: that he would bring everything together under Christ, as head, everything in the heavens and everything on earth."
