News from Reaching the Unreached:

Dear St Peter's, greetings from RTU. The beginning of June is always a busy time of year for us, as our schools open for the new academic year, and we welcome many new children to our Children's Villages and hostels. 106 new children have come into our care now that the older children have moved on to college. They are settling in well and have started in our schools, along with many new day scholars who are from the most disadvantaged families in the surrounding villages. Our four schools reopened on 10th June after a month-long summer break. Our students filled the campuses with excitement, reuniting with friends and eager to embark on a new academic journey.

We held a two-day training programme for 75 teachers to give them valuable tools for navigating the demands of their profession. The programme focused on teacher wellbeing, self-awareness, and fostering positive classroom environments. They also gained valuable insights into building healthy relationships and innovative teaching methods to keep students engaged and interested. This comprehensive programme left all the teachers feeling empowered and ready to tackle the new school year.

RTU's Mobile Science Lab programme also started again. In this academic year, the six science teachers plan to reach 101 schools and engage 7650 children in under-resourced rural schools with handson practical science experiments to foster enthusiasm for STEM subjects and to help them do well in their State board exams. Dr Ravichandran organised a one-day skin disease camp for the children of St Peter's Primary School, providing free check-ups

for the early detection and treatment of any skin conditions for students.

On 21 June, we held a ceremony to recognise the students who topped the 10th, 11th, and 12th State board exams. This event served as a glowing testament to the dedication and hard work put in by both the students and their teachers. Fr Antony presented awards to the high achievers. He also commended the teachers for their role in the students' success.



From the bottom of our hearts, thank you for your incredible generosity and recognition, especially during this time of collective need. Your kindness is truly humbling, and we feel immensely blessed by your support. Thanks to your contribution, we've made a significant difference in the poorest children through education. Sixteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

As we begin the holiday and pilgrimage season, our Parish Newsletter will cover the next three weeks and some of our usual parish ministries and activities also take a break for the Summer and return in September. In our Gospel today Jesus recognises the need for all of us to take a break. He says to the apostles: "... You must come away to some lonely place all by yourselves and rest for a while." So I hope you all manage a break in one way or another and enjoy some recreation. I like to think of that word as an invitation to

re-creation, slowing down so that we can appreciate in a deeper way God recreating us in the image of his Son. St. Mark tells us that as Jesus stepped ashore "...he set himself to teach them at some length." If we have some time this season, we could use some of it listening to Jesus through the pages of the Gospels as well as enjoying the creation we have been gifted.

When we all get back together again in September, I am delighted to say that we will welcome to our community Deacon Scott Coleman. Deacon Scott is what is called a 'transitional Deacon', that is, one who is on his way to being ordained a Priest, which God willing, will take place in the Summer next year. As part of his final year of Seminary studies Deacon Scott will be on placement with us here at St. Peter's. During the week he will be continuing his formation at Allen Hall Seminary in London and will join us for pastoral ministry at the weekends. I am sure he will also be involved in ministry in other parishes across the city as we prepare for the start of the moderated parish. Please keep Scott in your prayers as he prepares for priestly ministry in our Diocese. We need to continue to pray for vocations and also to think about how our community nurtures those young people who may experience a call to the priesthood and religious life. There may also be those men in our community who are discerning a call to the permanent Diaconate.

We all have a vital role to play in the life of the Church and when the Autumn arrives we will need to add people to those ministries which keep our parish alive and thriving. These are one's such as readers, eucharistic ministers, catechists, choir members and other important roles. Have a think and a pray, I might be asking you! God bless you, Canon David
