

The Solemnity of Saints Peter & Paul

Happy Feast Day! Although many of us will not be able to participate in person, the Confirmation of over sixty young people from our Deanery at the Cathedral this afternoon is a great way of celebrating our patronal feast. Saints Peter and Paul gave their lives for the building up of the Church, the Christian community. The Church thinks of Confirmation as a strengthening by the Holy Spirit to live the Christian life in the Church. This outpouring of the Holy Spirit is needed, as we know, and we need to think about the ways in which we all need to cooperate with this gift of God. Many of us who are older have been confirmed and rekindling and renewing the

gifts of the Holy Spirit within us will help those young people being confirmed today. Perhaps we can think about how accessible our Christian communities are to young people. There are no quick solutions available for our own renewal or for connecting more to young people. It is, however, important for us not to lose sight of these issues and today's feast offers us the chance to remind ourselves of our mission in this regard.

Our schools do fantastic work as do our university, college and school chaplaincies especially those operating in our Deanery. We need to continue to pray for them and assist them with our time and skills when and where we can, The person who attracts people to parish communities is Jesus Christ and he invites us to show him to others. That is the greatness of our baptismal vocation and that is why we need the Holy Spirit to overcome our weakness in meeting the responsibilities of our baptism. One of my favourite prayers during the baptism of a baby is the one said during the anointing with the oil of Chrism: "...As Christ was anointed Priest. Prophet and King, so may you live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life." A priest is one who serves, a prophet is one who tells the truth and king is one who leads. We all have to serve, be truthful and lead in our lives and the Holy Spirit helps us to do this as Jesus would renewing us and making a connection to those seeking him.
